A second letter from my office is attached to this one, and explains the status of other qualifications submitted by your institution.

May I express our appreciation of your co-operation on this phase of registration. We look forward to receiving your next submission prior to 30 June 2000. This submission will be of all **recorded qualifications** in the format contemplated in Regulation 11(1)(c) of the Government Gazette of 28 March 1998 (for details see the SAQA website). The processing of this submission by one or more of the National Standards Bodies will extend the interim registration of recorded qualifications to 30 June 2003.
