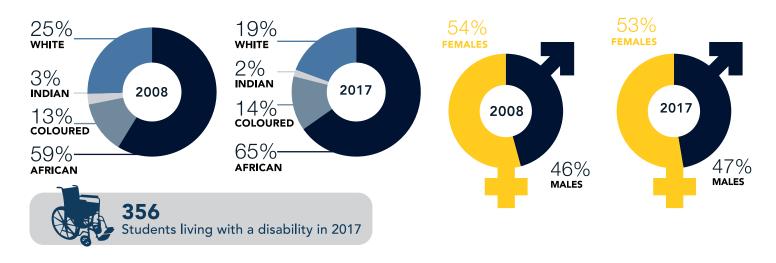

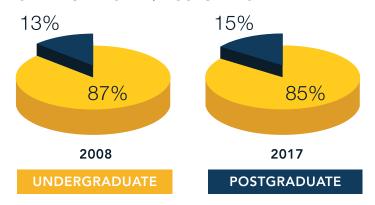

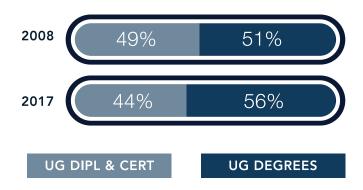
TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLMENTS BY ETHNICITY AND GENDER

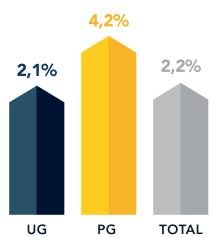

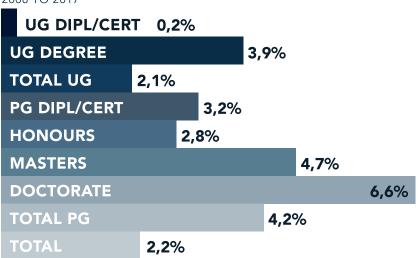
AVERAGE ANNUAL GROWTH RATE

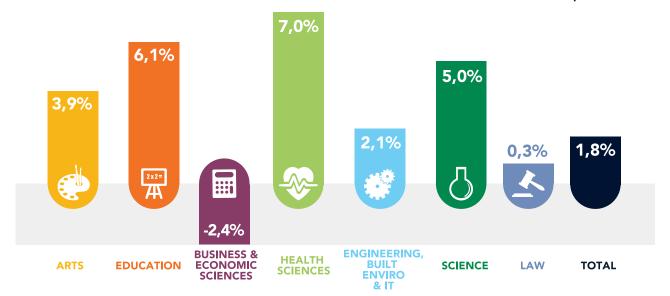


AVERAGE ANNUAL GROWTH RATE BY QUALIFICATION TYPE

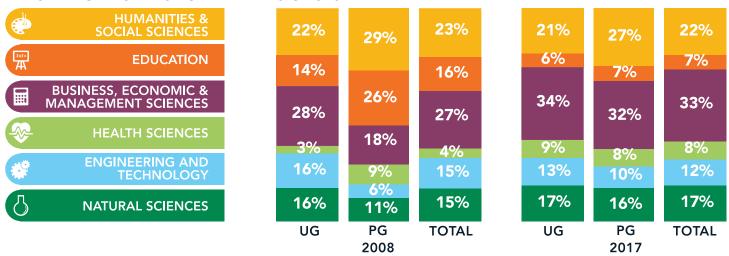

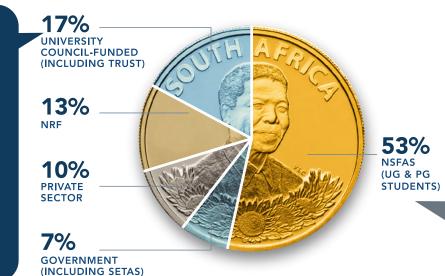

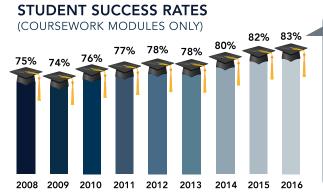

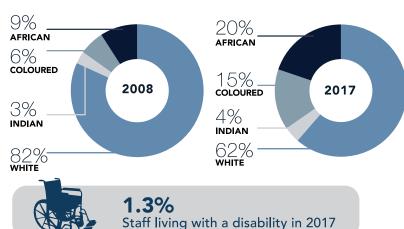

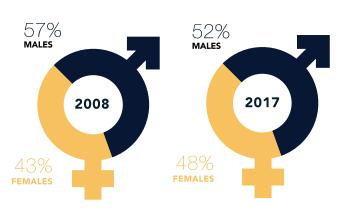

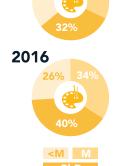

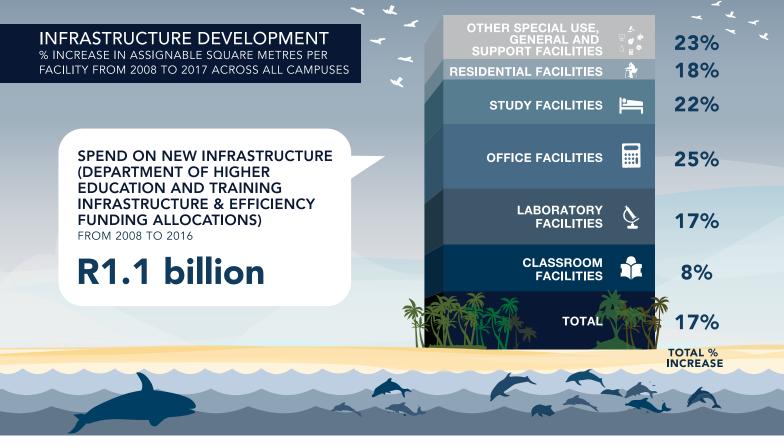

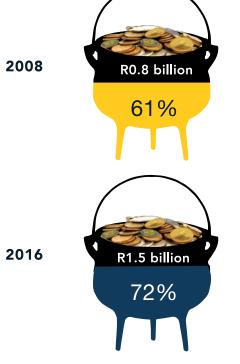

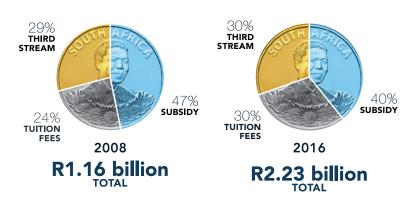
