




#### **OUR DEFINITION OF STUDENT SUCCESS**


#### SUCCESS RATES OF ALL COURSEWORK MODULES BY FACULTY 2020 - 2021


# RETENTION OF FIRST-TIME ENTERING STUDENTS BY FACULTY 2021 - 2022

GROWTH RATES FOR 2017 TO 2021 COMPARED TO THE NATIONAL AVERAGE



The graduates increased at a lower average annual growth rate (1.2%) than the enrolments (1.9%) as compared to the national averages which is an indicator of a decline in efficiency


# THROUGHPUT RATES\* FOR FIRST-TIME ENTERING COHORTS BY QUALIFICATION TYPE 2021





# **RATIOS OF WEIGHTED RESEARCH OUTPUTS PER ACADEMIC STAFF MEMBER 2021**




# **NUMBER OF RESEARCH ARTICLES PUBLISHED 2019 - 2021**
