Let's comply and keep each other safe!

Follow the on-campus rules:

- Always wear your mask in public and shared areas
- Wash your hands with soap and water or sanitise your hands frequently with hand sanitiser containing at least 70% alcohol
- Keep your distance from others (a distance of at least 1.5 2 metres is recommended)
- Do not participate in any unauthorised gatherings/events/functions
- The use of alcohol and any other illegal substance is prohibited on university premises and students are not to return to residences intoxicated after being off campus
- Adhere to the curfew in place for residence students
- Sanitize the equipment you have used/touched, within the venues where you are required to do so, with the cleaning products provided
- Staff who enforce these rules are to be respected and obeyed, and
- Any other area/venue specific rules that may be applicable during this time.

Report COVID-19 Non-Compliance

Hand sanitiser missing? No-one wearing masks? Visitors avoiding screening at entrances? Staff absent from their COVID-19 work stations?

You can anonymously report any non-compliance COVID-19 regulations by using the new online tool accessible on both the staff and student portals.

The incident form takes you step-by-step through the reporting process including:

- Location of the non-compliance
- Type of non-compliance, including a space for other misdemeanors not included in the drop-down menu
- An opportunity to upload a photograph of the non-compliance

Track your case

The system allows you to track the progress of the reported incident
