SHUTTLE RULES

- Only registered students can use the shuttle services.
- Students must produce their student card before entering the shuttle.
- Students are not allowed to use the shuttle services without a face mask.
- Eating is prohibited inside the shuttle vehicles.

Students are urged to always carry their student cards as the boarding pass to shuttles and all the University boom gates for access. Shuttle drivers will not permit any student/s to board shuttle in the absence of student card, and the Security Officers will scan student cards to a morpho tablet system (no student card no access).
