THE VACCINE #SMARTPLAN

Our **#smartplan** starts with vaccinating South Africa's 1.25-million healthcare workers.

These essential foot soldiers **keep us safe** – so we need to **take care of them** and **keep them safe, too**.

Phases 2 and 3 focus on other essential workers, people in charge of large institutions or organisations, people over 60, over-18s with comorbidities and lastly, all citizens over 18.

The #smartplan

South Africa is using technology to smoothly kickstart the vaccine roll-out process.

Government's **Electronic Vaccination Data System (EVDS)** is an easy self-registration tool aimed at capturing relevant data of all citizens who will – and have been – vaccinated.

It will **initially only be used for healthcare workers** in Phase 1 of the roll-out.

The EVDS will help the government to:

- + Identify eligible vaccination beneficiaries
- + Plan supply of vaccines and ancillary items
- + Allocate beneficiaries to their nearest vaccine service point
- + Communicate with registered participants about the vaccination programme

The EVDS will also provide this **important information**:

- + Eligibility for vaccine (depending on age, health status, job, etc.)
- + When and where to be vaccinated
- + Follow-up vaccination appointments.



Once you're eligible to register on the EVDS, have the following information handy:

- + ID number or passport (non-RSA citizen)
- + General contact information (your cellphone will be the main way to contact you)
- + Employment information (your job, where you work, etc.).

Registration on the 3-step system should take between 2-3 minutes.
