FAST FACTS

YES, the vaccine stops most people from becoming ill with COVID-19

YES, a small percentage of people may still catch COVID-19 and become a little ill after the vaccine

BUT, vaccinated COVID-19 patients may have been MORE sick, or died, without vaccination.

When a person infected with COVID-19 coughs, sneezes or talks, their respiratory droplets can **travel about two metres** and land in another person's nose or mouth, infecting them.

The virus can also be spread by people who have **NO** symptoms.
